
A look back into the host of events that the Student Council members organised and participated in during the term 2022-23.


Paisa double was a blitz game, in which the participant played against one of our university players and the winner was given back the doubled money. We had one winner for that event.



0000 Dance Club @ Christmas Celebration




Creative Head Election
